Note 1	Pursuant to Section 248 of the <i>Building Act 1993</i> , a person must not act on behalf of an owner of a building or land for the purpose of making any application, appeal or referral under this <i>Act</i> or the regulations unless the person is authorised in writing by the owner to do so. Penalty: \$18,655.
Note 2	Building owners written consent allowing temporary occupation of the building.
Note 3	A site plan that is drawn to scale must be submitted with this application and show the proposed location of the structure/s on the site and show the distance from the temporary structure/s to the nearest other features. eg: footpath, roadway, temporary marquees, permanent buildings etc.
	A site plan that is drawn to scale must be submitted with this application showing the extent of the site boundary fencing, unsafe areas and the details, location of emergency assembly areas, access for emergency services, details of lighting and proposed drinking water fountains / tap and toilet facilities.
Note 4	Location of fireworks, amusement rides, naked flames and the like must be marked on the site plan for the event. Further information will be required should the event include any of the proposed features.
Note 5	Copy of Council / Vic Roads approved Traffic Management Plans must be provided for changed traffic conditions.
