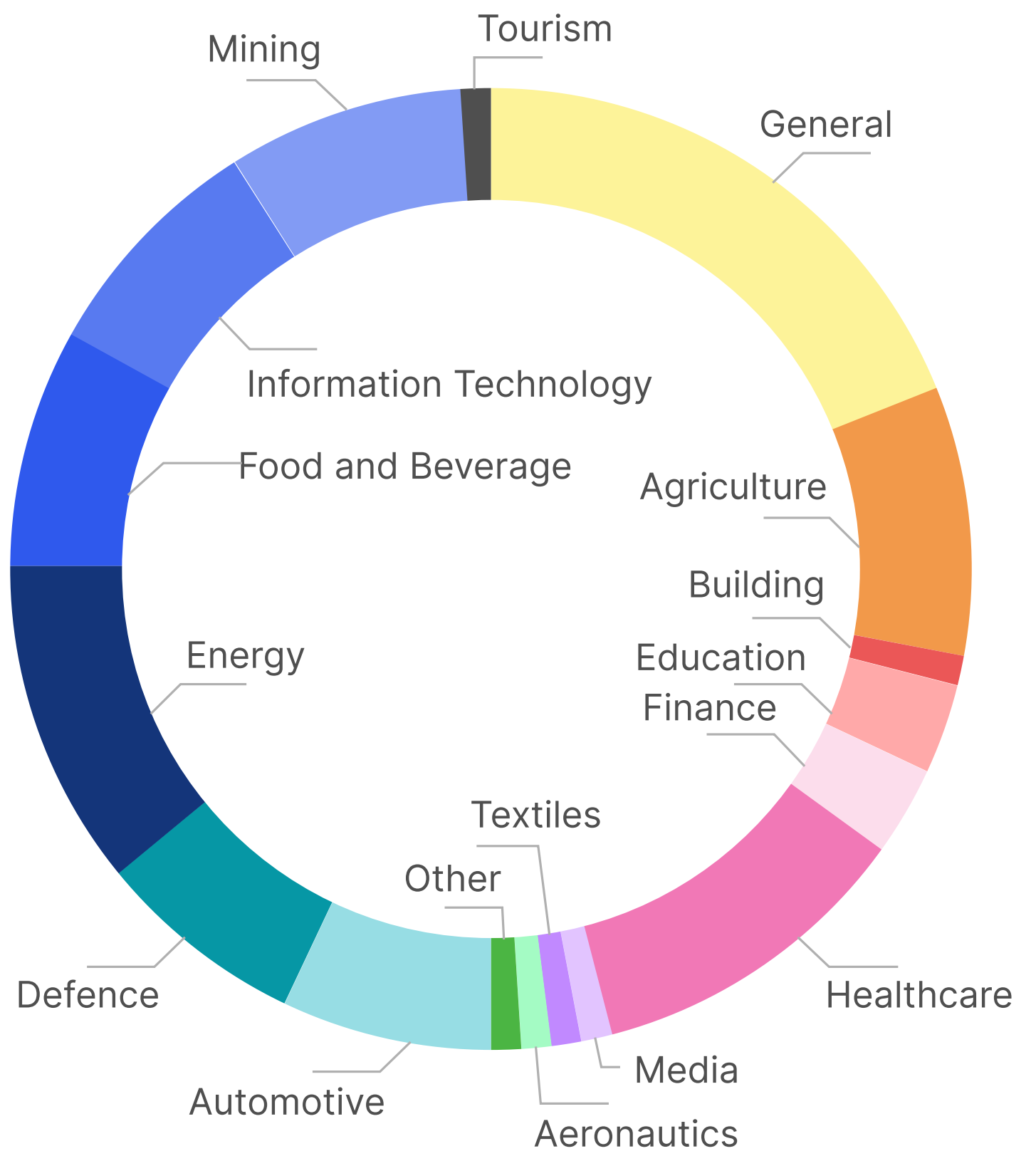

In Australia, grants are financial awards provided by the government, private organisations, or foundations to support a wide range of activities, including research, community projects, education, and more. They are designed to help individuals, organisations, and businesses achieve specific goals and contribute to societal advancement.

Key Features

- **Non-Repayable:** Grants do not need to be repaid, unlike loans.
- **Purpose-Driven:** Grants are usually allocated for specific purposes, such as research, education, community service, or business innovation.
- **Can be competitive:** Applications are assessed against specific criteria and competition can be intense.

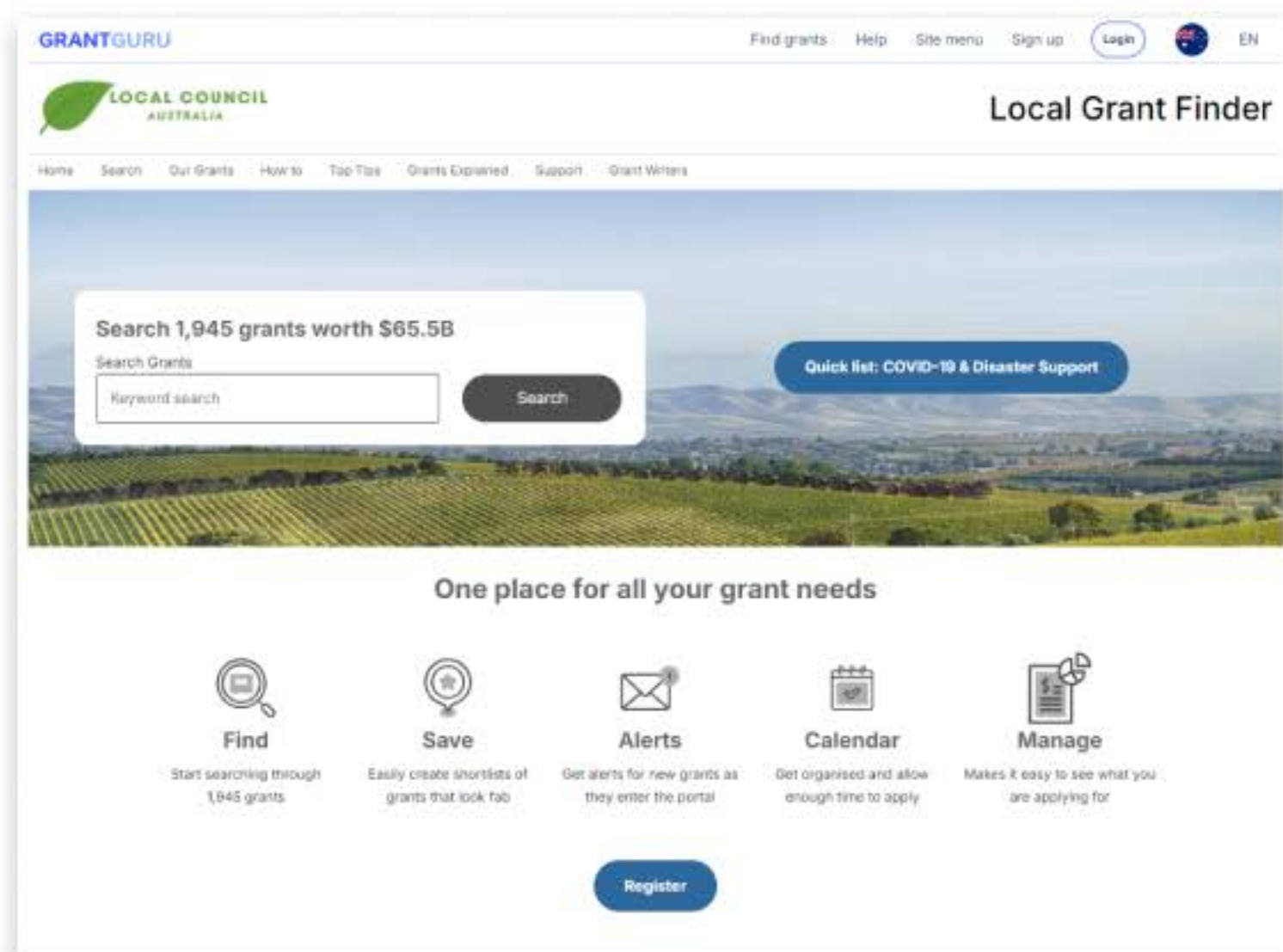

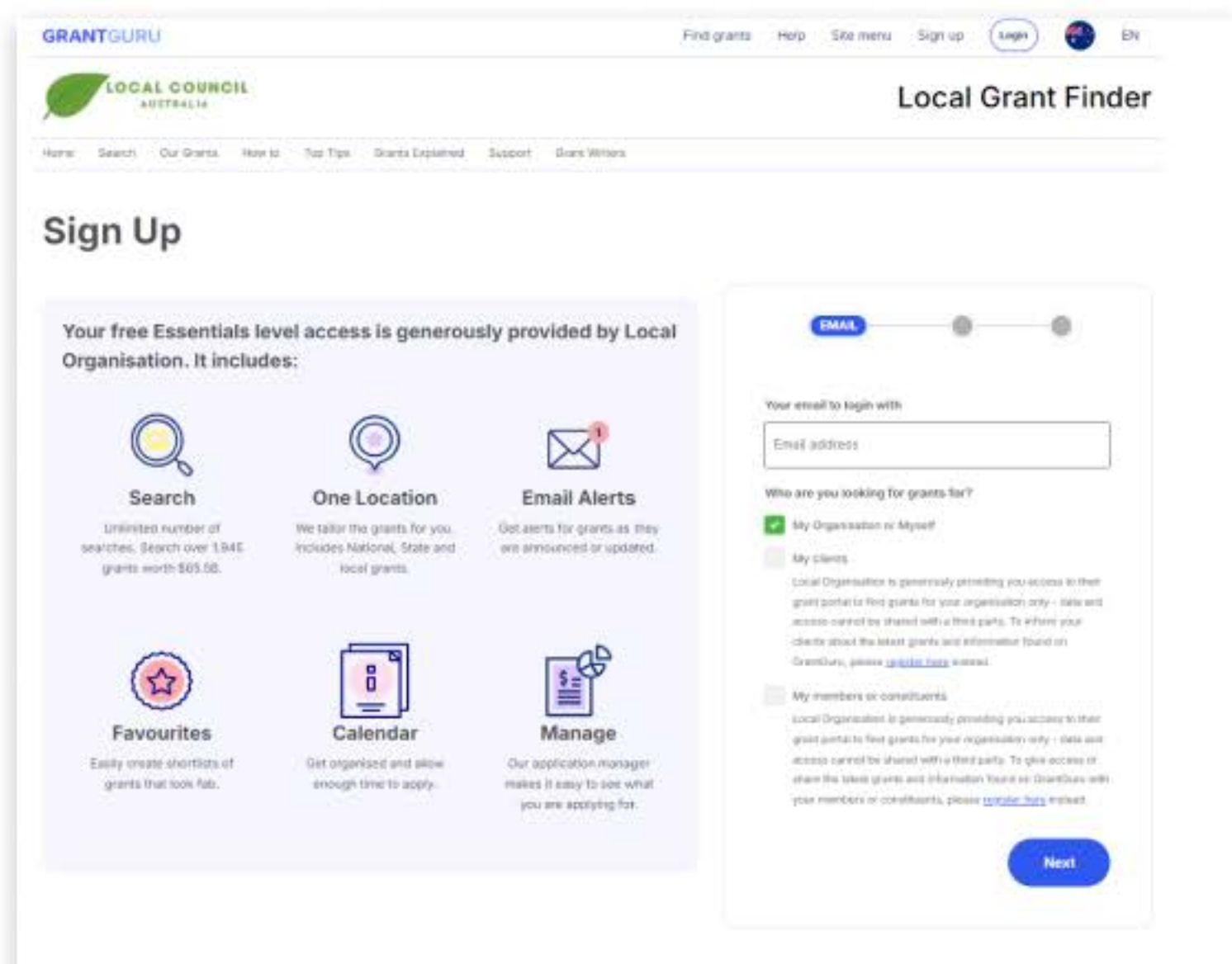

1. From your local portal, click 'Sign Up'.

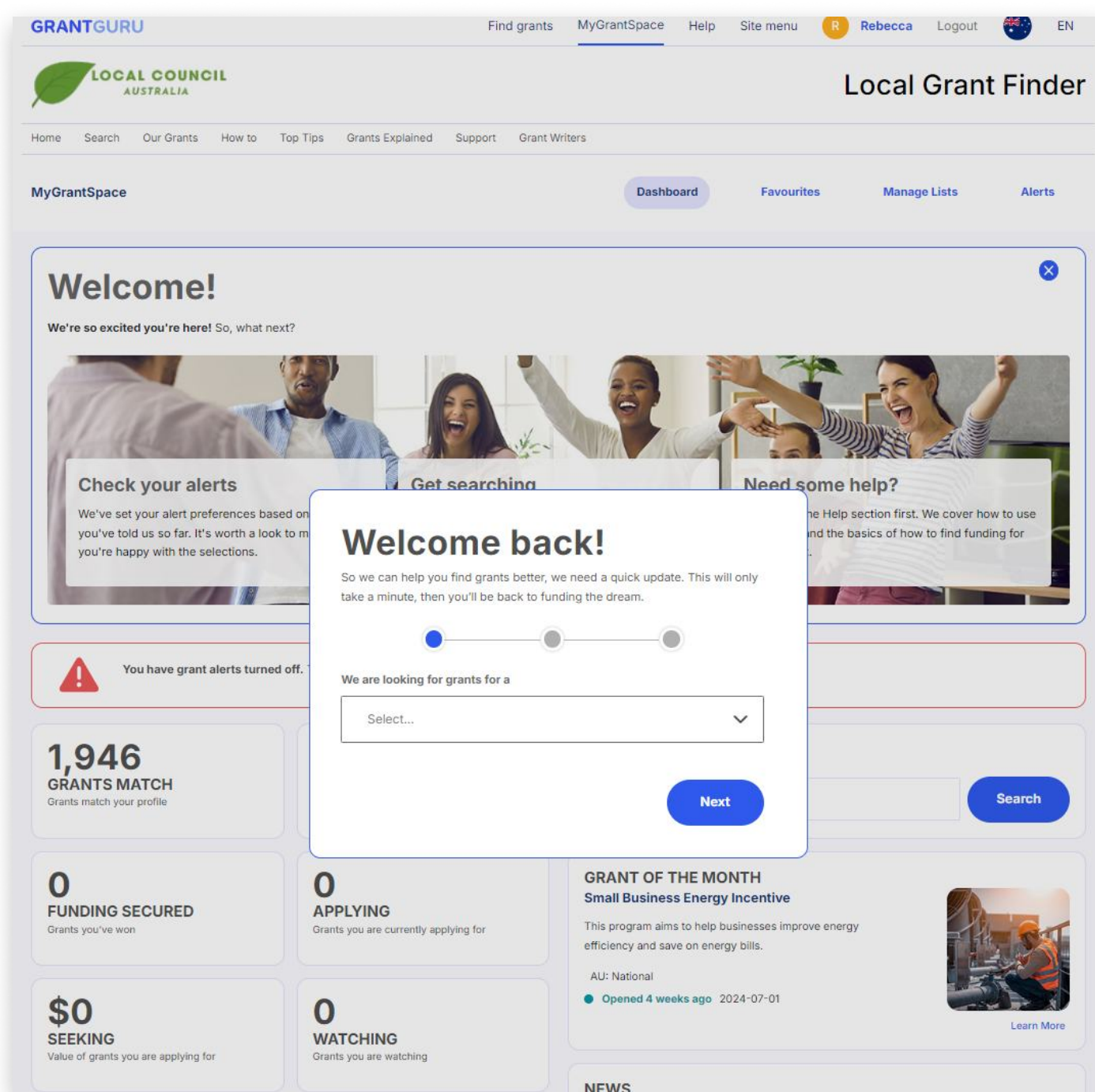


2. Follow the prompts and answer the questions to sign up

Once you have registered you will be able to now start customising the portal for your needs. You can start searching, making a list of appropriate grants and exploring the tools provided to you.

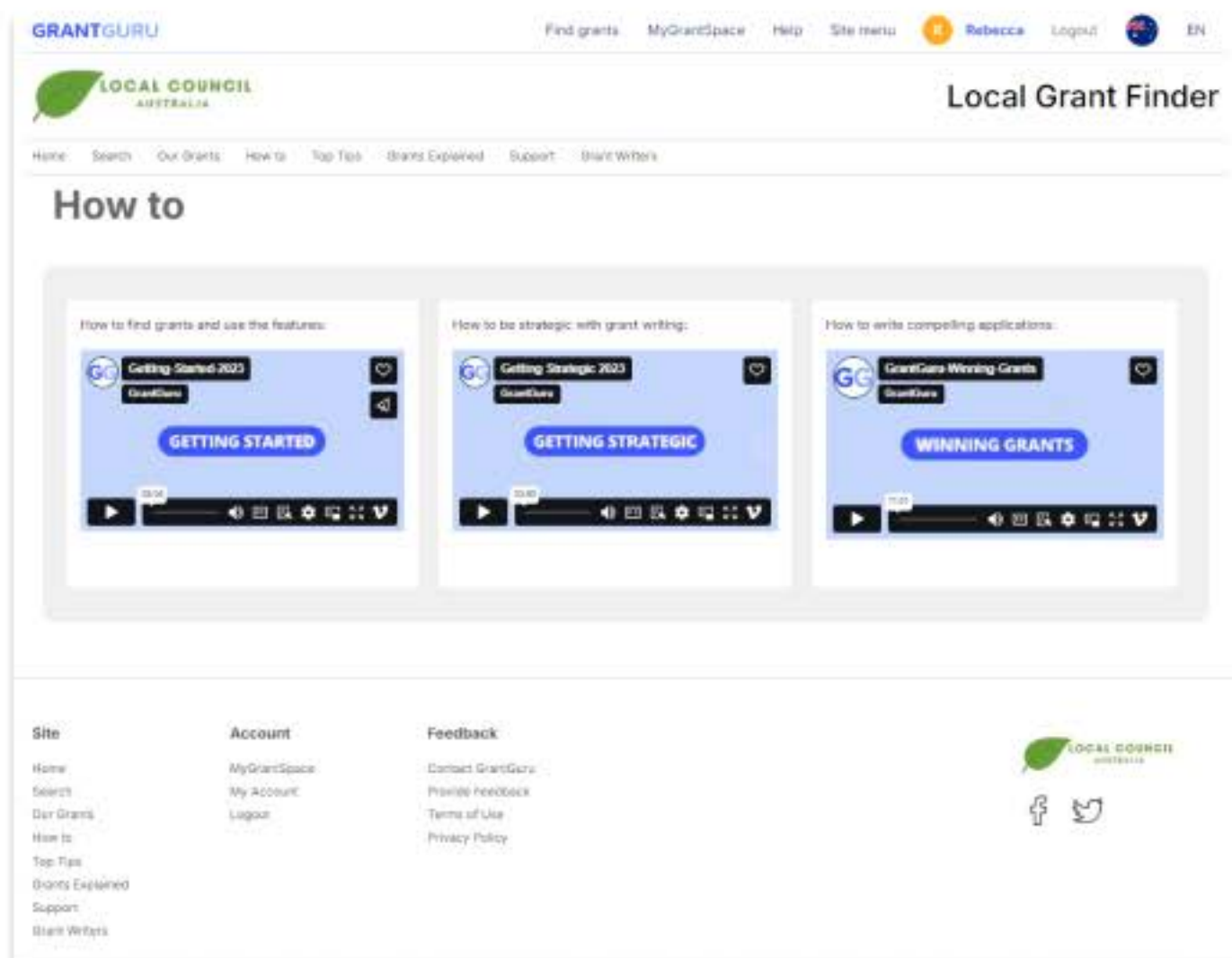
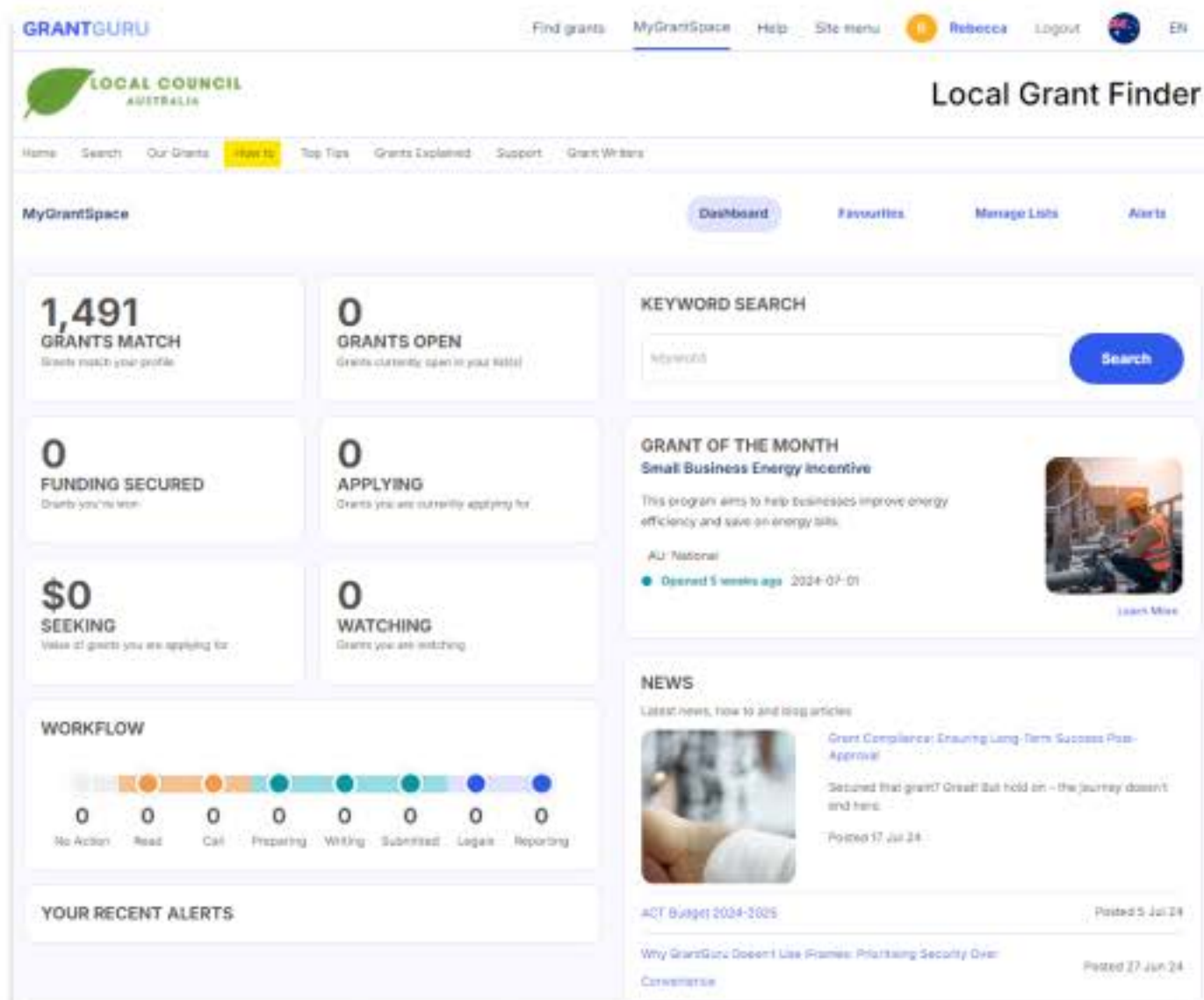

Stay informed with alerts

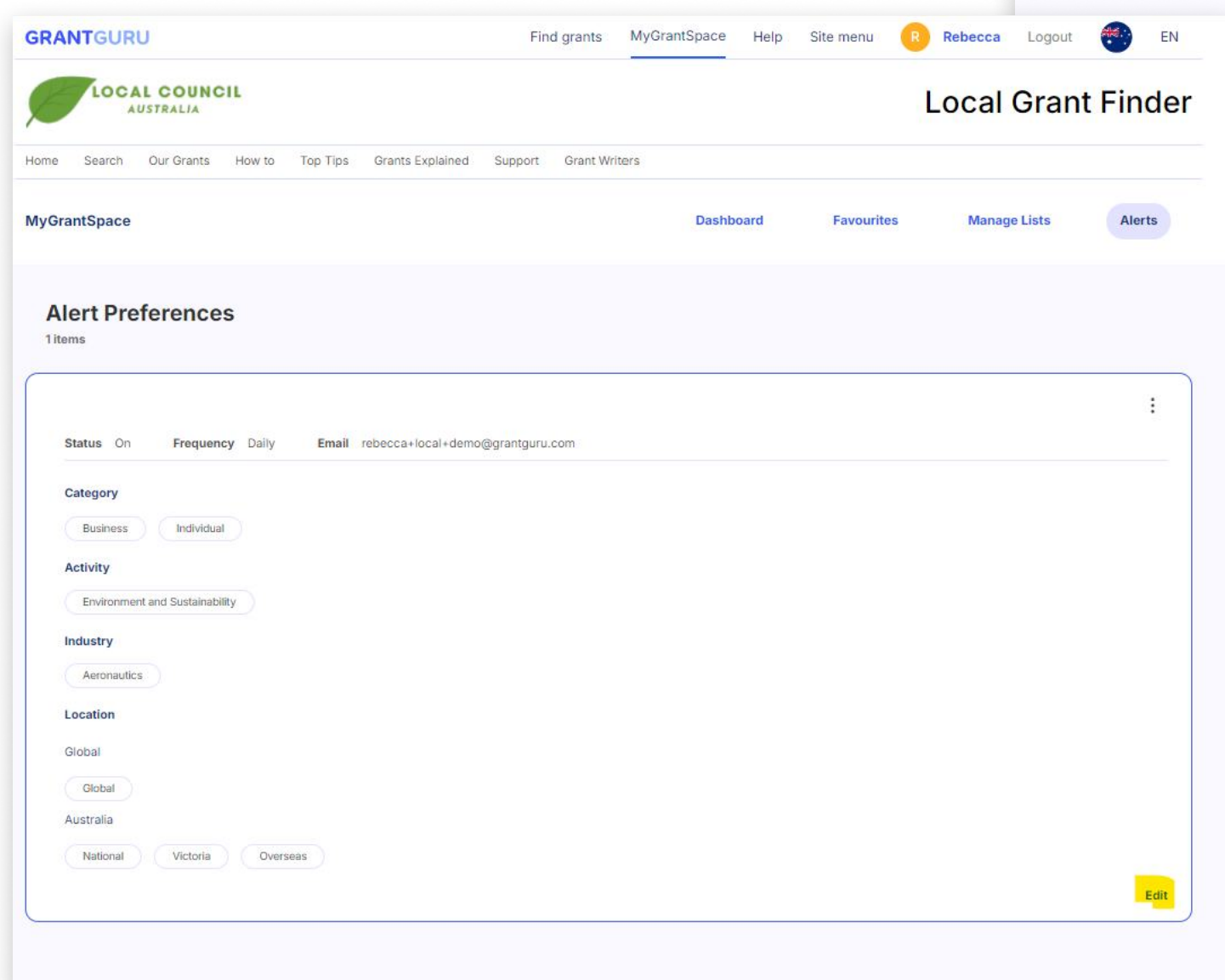
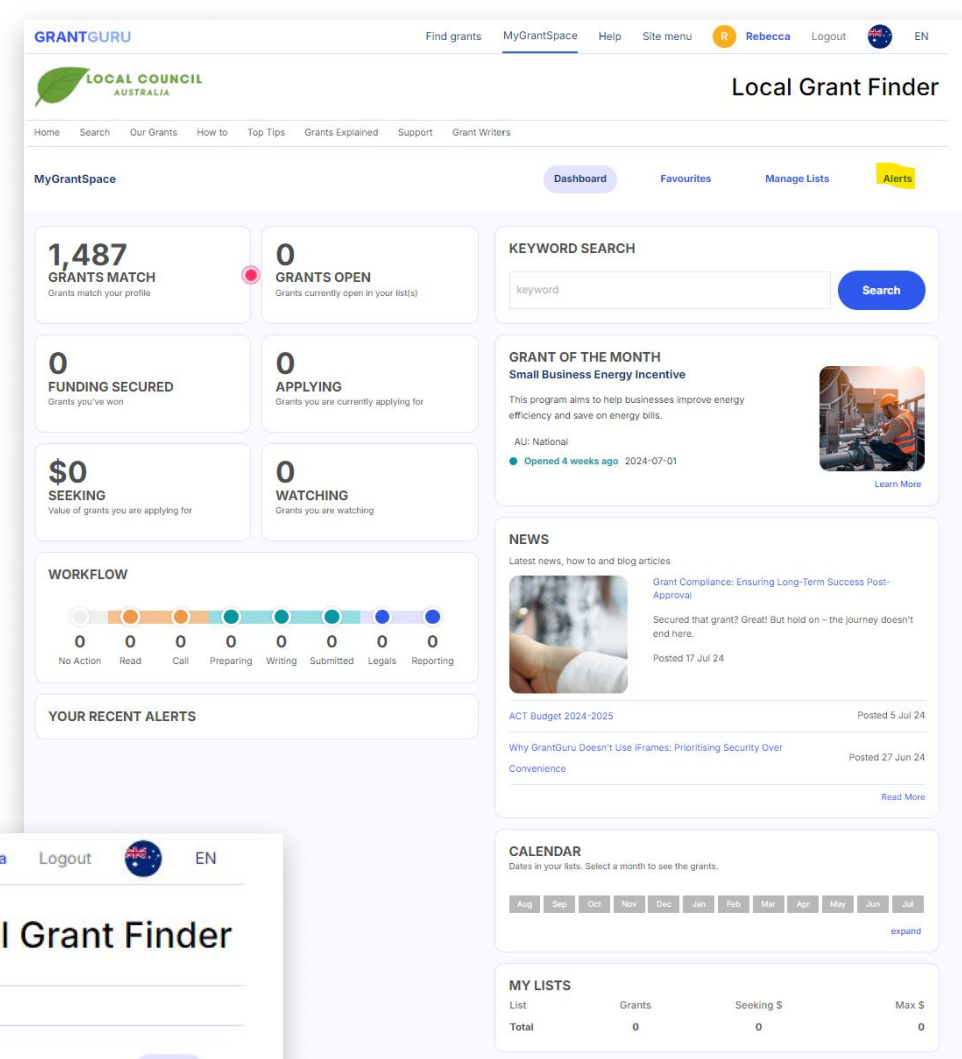
10 new grants are added, and 30 open, every week.

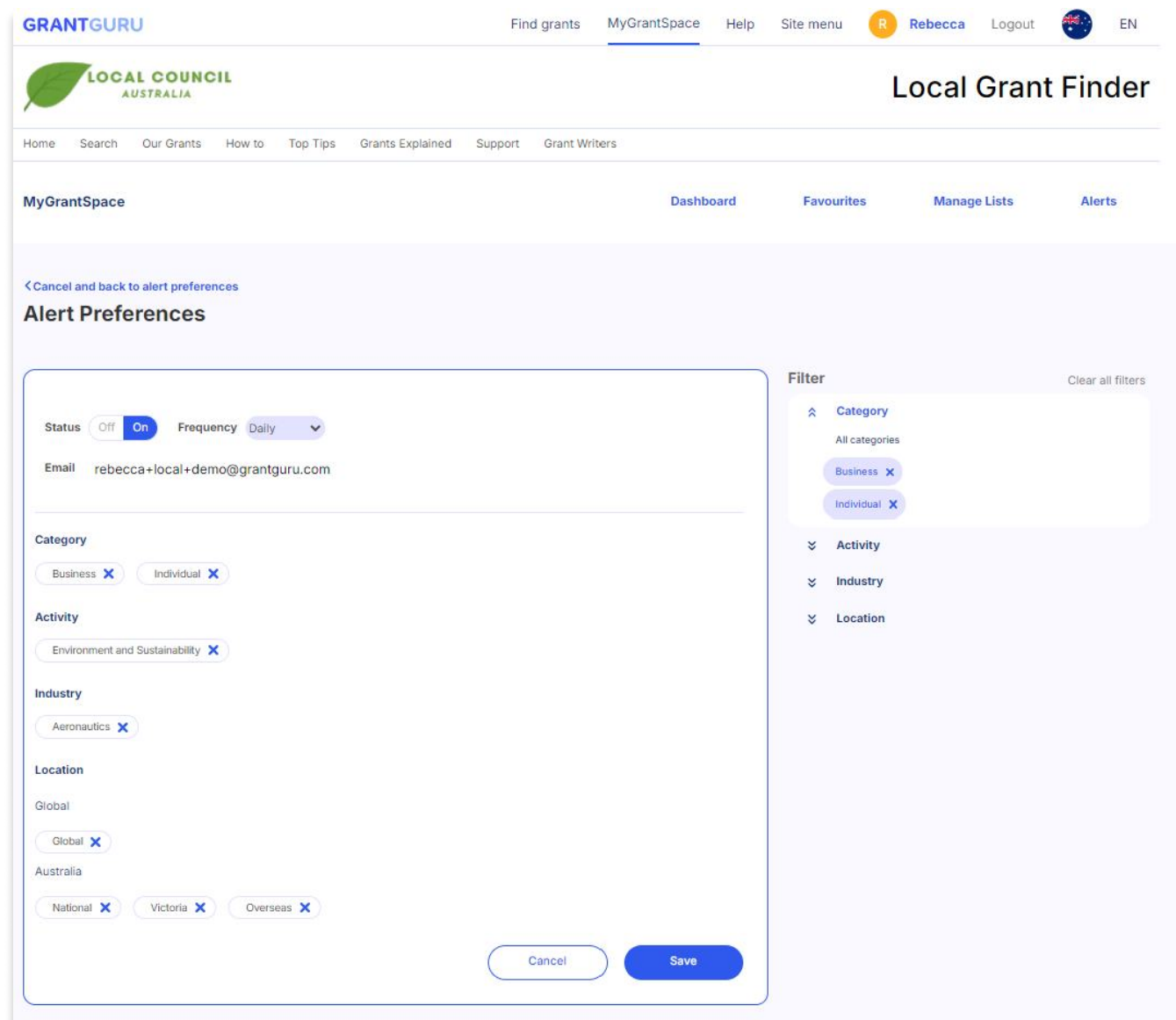
We'll also email you when grants in your favourites are updated.

1. From your Dashboard, click on alerts. Alternatively you can access alerts from the menu - MyGrantSpace → Alerts

2. On the alerts page, click edit

3. Optimise your alerts by selecting the frequency you wish to be notified, the categories, activity, industry and location you wish to be notified about.

4. Press save when you are done!

You're all set!

Now that your alerts are all setup there is no need to worry about missing out on information about the grants you are interested in. You will now be notified of all new and amended grants that fit within the options you have set for your email alerts without logging into the portal.
